



- During the month of **October**, we welcomed the arrival of Fall and explored the many facets of **Weather**. We learned about the four seasons and how the change of seasons brings the various weather conditions we experience. At **Circle Time**, we observed and discussed the daily weather. The children were very excited to record the observations in their own "Daily Weather Calendar" by gluing weather icons to each day of the week. We also made "weather word" booklets to expand our vocabulary and practice handwriting skills
- We examined the beauty of **Rainbows** and discussed which colors make up a rainbow. Our friends were especially excited to perform an experiment where they made a real rainbow. The children also enjoyed making weather elements into art by lacing yarn through clouds, raindrops, and rainbows.

The children showed special interest in learning about the **Climates** in different parts of the world. Everyone was amazed at the effects of climate on living styles, environment and habitat. We made climate charts to illustrate the many types of climates.





Our little "scientists" performed a fun experiment to demonstrate the water cycle. The children completed a fun cutting and gluing activity and made water cycle booklets too...


